ABOUT TERMITE

There are an estimated 4,000 species of termites in the world - about 10 % of which have been identified as being responsible for damage to homes, crops, and plantation forests. Termites are grouped into categories based on their feeding habits; the most common groupings being subterranean, soil-feeding, drywood, dampwood etc. As their names suggest, the subterranean and drywood species wreak the most havoc on homes and buildings. Termite colonies can number anywhere from several hundred to several million.

Post Construction Treatment: The post construction treatment is strictly given as per the specification laid down by ISI vide their code IS: 6313 (Part III): 1981 which include followings:

- Soil treatment
- Treatment along outside of foundations.
- Treatment of soil under floor.
- Treatment to voids in masonry.
- Treatment to wood works.
- Treatment of termite runways and tubes.
- Treatment of electric fixtures.
